DANGER

Highly inflammable liquids and vapour. Can causes skin irritation. May be fatal if swallowed and may cause drowsiness, dizziness, and genetic defect. Suspected to damaging the unborn child or the central nervous system by inhalation.

PREVENTION

- Keep away from :
 - Heat
 - Sunlight
 - Sprays
 - Open Flames
 - Children
 - Water
 - Un-uniformed Personnel
 - Food Stuff
- No smoking near the container
- Keep container tightly closed
- Do not breath vapour or mist
- Wash hands and any other contaminated skin thoroughly after handling
- Wear protective gloves, gear and eye protection
- Use only outdoors or in a wall-ventilated area
- Get medical advice/attention if you feel unwell
- Obtain special instructions before use
- Store under lock and keep in a well-ventilated area
- Wash thoroughly after use
- Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood

STORAGE

- Store indoors in original, tightly sealed containers between 5°C and 30°C
- Protect from freezing and direct sunlight

- Toxic if swallowed and in contact with skin.
- Flammable.
- Toxic to aquatic life.

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RESPONSE TO FIRE

In case of fire : Use foam, water-spray or fog. Dry chemical, carbon dioxide or sand may be used for small fires only. DO NOT use water in a jet.

FIRST-AID

- 1.If Swallowed : Immediately call a poison centre or doctor. DO NOT induce vomiting.
- 2.If Inhaled : Move the exposed person to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration. If breathing is difficult, give oxygen. Get medical attention if breathing difficulties persist.
- 3.If on Skin or Hair : Take off immediately all contaminated clothing. Rinse skin with plenty of hand cleaner, mineral oil, or petroleum jelly and water/shower. Wash contaminated clothing before reuse. If irritation occurs : Get medical attention.
- 4.If on Eyes : Flush eyes with water. If material was heated, flush eyes immediately with fresh water for 15 minutes while holding the eyelids open. If no change : Get medical attention

SAFE DISPOSAL OF EMPTY CONTAINER AND EXPIRED CHEMICALS

Do not reuse empty containers for any other purpose. Empty containers and expired products should be treated as hazardous waste and should be disposed of in accordance with hazardous waste regulations and with the consent from the relevant Local Regulatory Authority.
